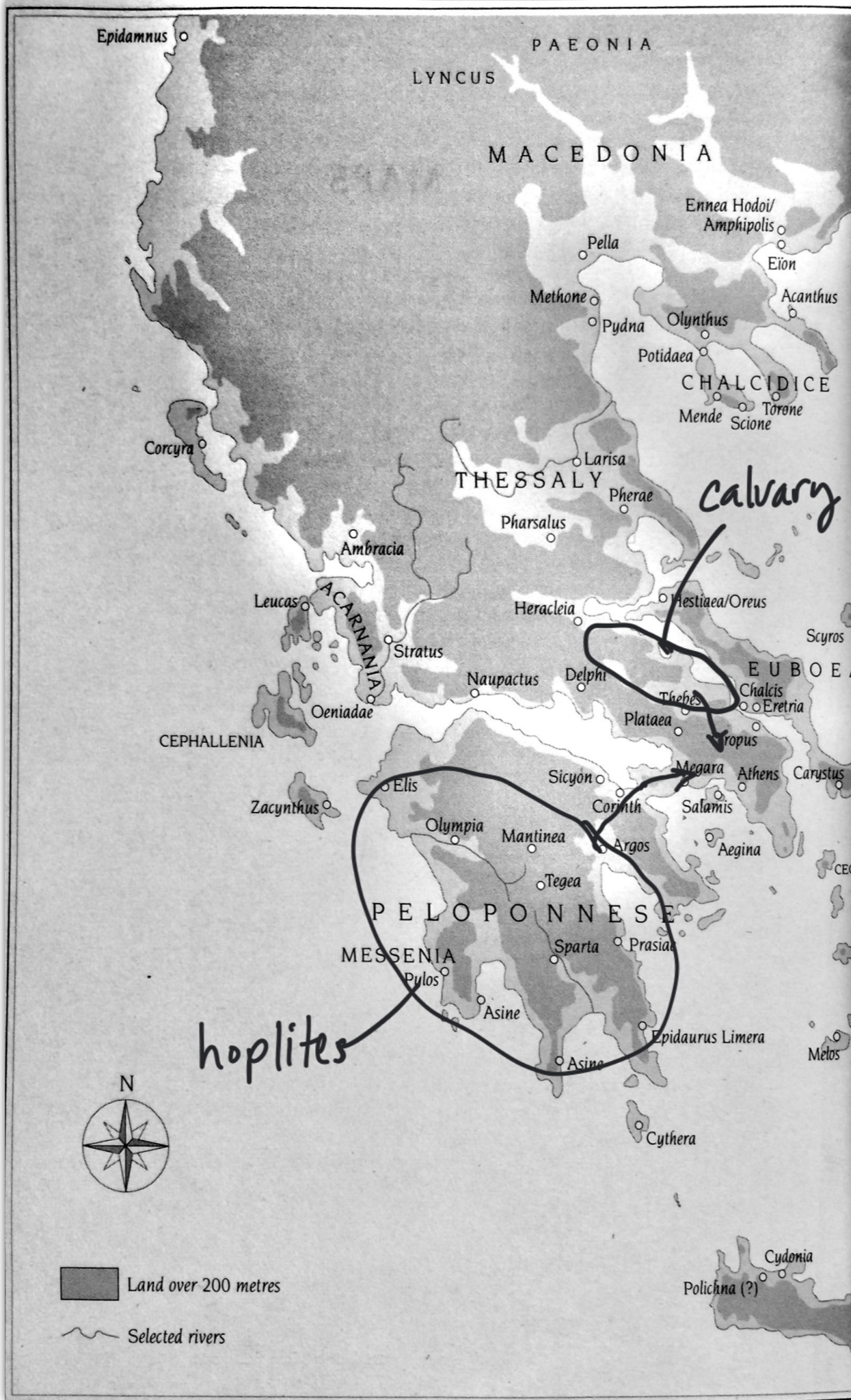


Book II Mobilization

> Mandate > no Spartan heralds as long mobilization is occurring.

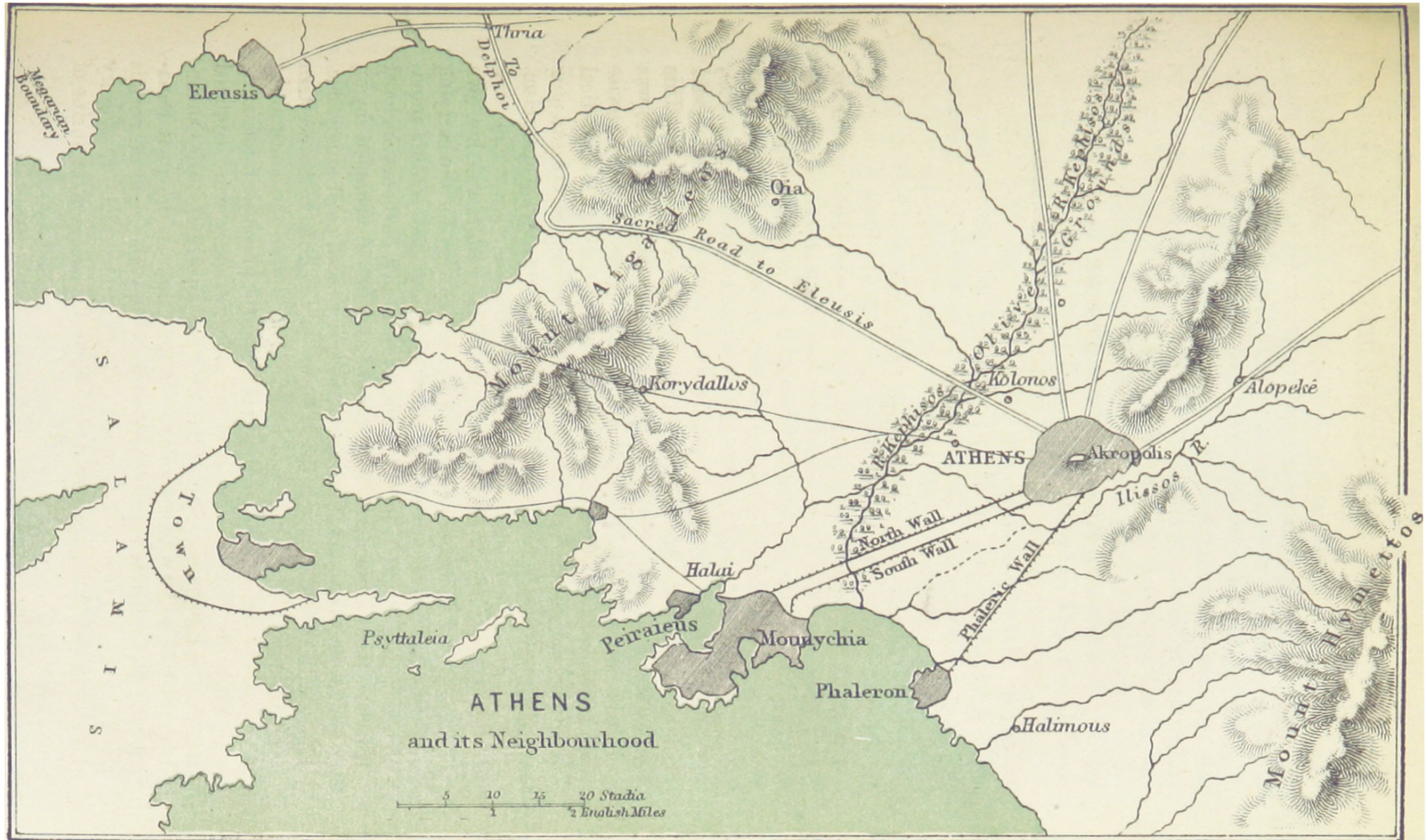
> Reminds the Athenians of strength

- > protect the walls →
- > 13,000 hoplites

 - cavalry
- > 300 triremes

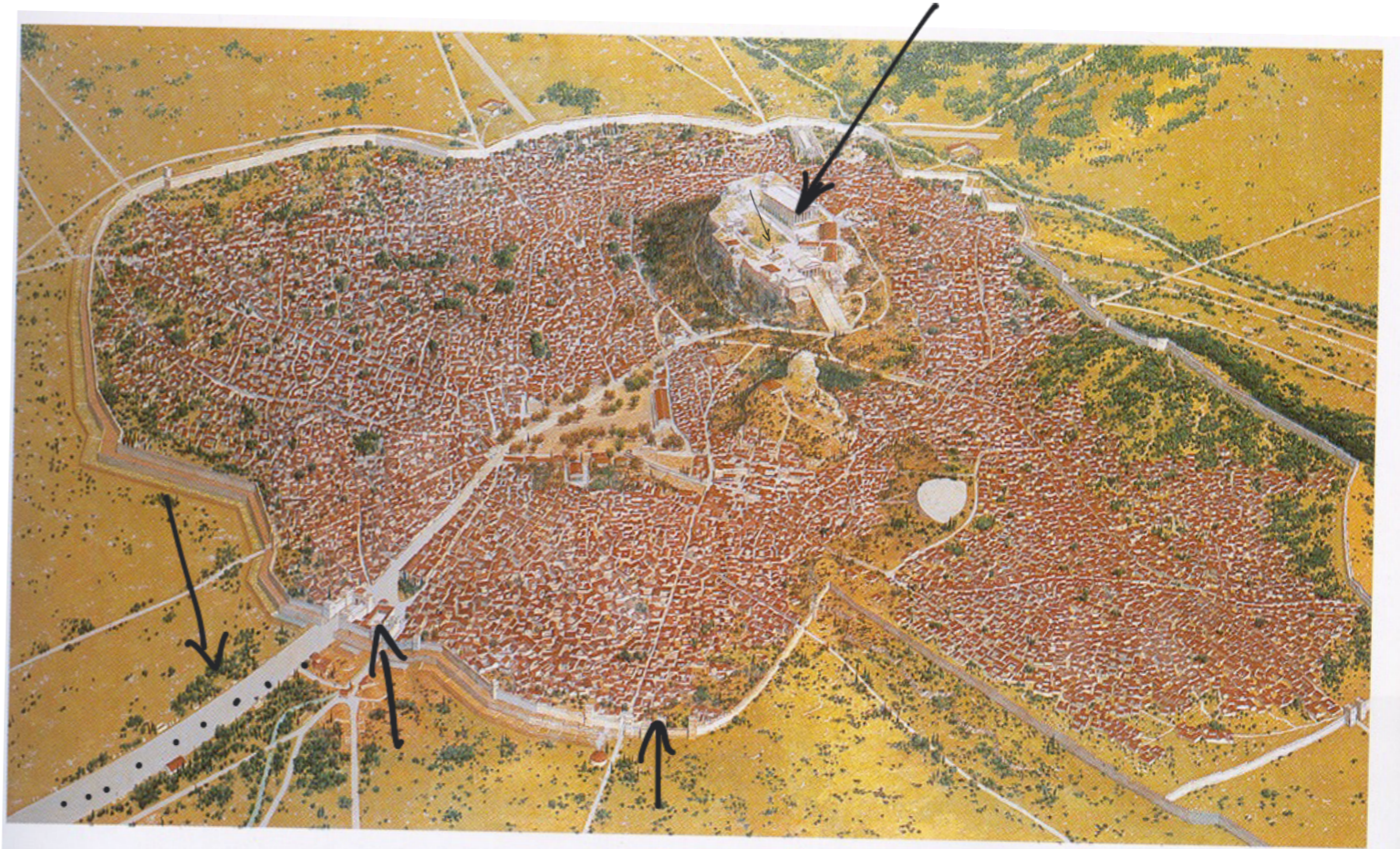
